Current Success

To address the growing need to educate commercialization professionals, the Georgia Institute of Technology was awarded a contract to create a universally applicable technology transfer course. After a successful pilot in 2021, the decision was made to continue the course and expand it into other languages. The ITCP Course has now been translated into Chinese, French, and Spanish, and more than 1200 learners from around the world have passed the course and earned their certificate.
